Afternoon at the Navy Pier

Monday, October 6, 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Located on Lake Michigan, just East of Chicago's Downtown, Navy Pier has been a Chicago landmark since it first opened in 1916. Originally designed as both a shipping and recreational facility, the Pier also served as a military training site during two world wars, a venue for concerts and exhibitions, and the temporary home for a once-fledgling University of Illinois' Chicago campus.

Navy Pier is the place where all of Chicagoland and tourists from around the world have come together since 1995 to enjoy the beauty and the thrills of a day on Lake Michigan. From rides to restaurants, exhibitions to entertainment, shopping to dining cruises and tour boats, Navy Pier has it all - in a location unlike any other!

Not to be missed at the Navy Pier is the **Smith Museum of Stained Glass Windows**.

The Smith Museum of Stained Glass Windows is a permanent display of 150 stained glass windows housed in an 800-ft.-long series of galleries along the lower level terraces of Festival Hall. Open since February 2000, it is the first museum in the United States dedicated solely to stained glass windows. It showcases both secular and religious windows and is divided by artistic theme into four categories: Victorian, Prairie, Modern and Contemporary. All of the windows were designed by prominent local, national and European studios and most were originally installed in Chicago area residential, commercial and religious buildings.

There's so much to do in the 50 acres of parks, promenades, gardens, shops, eateries and attractions in the Navy Pier. Enjoy the afternoon!

The Pride of the Chicago Park District: the historic 18-hole golf course has mature hardwood trees protecting the fairway and greens putting emphasis on accurate shots.

Jackson Park golf course opened in 1897 and features 5,463 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72. The course rating is 65.7 and it has a slope rating of 107.
