Villa Vizcaya, built in 1916 and now named the Vizcaya Museum and Gardens, is the former villa and estate of businessman James Deering of the Deering McCormick-International Harvester fortune. Located on Biscayne Bay in the present-day Coconut Grove neighborhood of Miami, the early 20™ century Vizcaya estate is decorated and furnished with antiques from Europe. There are extensive Italian Renaissance gardens, a native woodland landscape, and a historic village compound. The landscape and architecture were influenced by Veneto and Tuscan Italian Renaissance models and designed in the Mediterranean Revival architecture style with Baroque elements.
